

2008 Summer Mentoring Program for Science Scholars Program

The Center for Mathematics, Science and Environmental Education at Metropolitan State College of Denver seeks twenty high school sophomores and juniors to participate in the Summer Science Institute, a summer science camp for middle school students from Rocky Mountain Middle School Math and Science Partnership (RM-MSMSP) participating school districts. The high school students will participate in one session of the two-week long middle school camp and will act as mentors for the middle school students involved in that two week session. This two-week program of learning science and science reasoning skills through active hands-on science is funded in part by *Rocky Mountain Middle School Math and Science Partnership and the National Science Foundation*. All high school students will participate in a **mandatory training** for this experience which will be in the Science Building on the Auraria Campus at 4:00 pm on **Friday, May 30, 2008**.

Each student who participates in this Mentoring Program will receive a stipend of \$260 upon completion of the mentoring responsibilities.
