

Metropolitan State College of Denver Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)

Metropolitan State College of Denver is the third largest college in Colorado, enrolling more than 21,000 students. We are located on 127 park-like acres in the heart of downtown Denver, creating a safe and exhilarating campus experience. Our average class size is 22 and our faculty are passionate about teaching. Metro State works hard to keep tuition affordable and provide access to substantial financial aid. We are a commuter campus and do not offer residence halls.

What is WUE?

WUE is the Western Undergraduate Exchange, a program of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE). Through WUE, students in western states (AK, AZ, CA, CO, HI, ID, MT, NV, NM, ND, OR, SD, UT, WA, WY) may enroll in many two-year and four-year college programs at a reduced tuition level: 150 percent of the institution's regular resident tuition. WUE tuition is considerably less than non-resident tuition.

Metro State majors open to WUE students on a space-available basis:

Accounting; Behavioral Science; Business Management; Civil Engineering Technology; Computer Information Systems; Computer Science; Criminal Justice/Criminology; Health Care Management; History; Hospitality, Tourism and Events; Human Performance and Sport; Human Services; Land Use; Meteorology; Modern Languages; Nursing (upper-division for RN's or Accelerated Nursing for students with a previous Bachelor's degree); Political Science; Psychology; Social Work; Surveying and Mapping; and Theatre.

Conditions for enrollment under WUE:

WUE is open to students who meet both Metro State admission and WUE program requirements. Qualified students must apply and be admitted to Metro State and must submit the attached WUE New Student Participation Form to the Office of Admissions. Students must also provide proof of residency in one of the WUE participating states. A copy of one of the following credentials will satisfy the residency requirement: driver's license, state tax filing, most recent pay stub or lease agreement/proof of home ownership.

Maintaining WUE status:

Every semester, participants must maintain good academic standing (2.0 or better cumulative GPA), be enrolled in an approved major and meet with a WUE academic advisor to register for classes. Online registration is not available to WUE students.
