The course is designed for Engineering and Engineering Technology graduates and seniors, and others who need a review before taking the National Fundamentals of Engineering Exam.

The F.E. Review will be held at Metropolitan State College of Denver on eight Saturday mornings, August 22nd through October 17th, 2009, from 8:00 AM until noon ([unless noted in online schedule](#)). The classes will be in the South Classroom Building, Room 212, on the Auraria Campus.

Required donation for registration includes a copy of Michael R. Lindeburg's EIT Review Manual, Solutions Manual, and NCEE FE Reference Handbook (provided at the first review session or at time of an in person payment). The books will be available for purchase to those who are unable to attend the course.

F.E. Examination is given by the State in April and October (MSCD seniors need to contact Dr. Mingli He he@mscd.edu for **student F.E. Examination application** deadline).
