

CCC BUILDINGS AT PARKDALE RAZED TO BE MOVED TO PANDO

CANON CITY, Sept. 4—The civilian conservation camp established at Parkdale but a year ago and abandoned about two months ago, is being moved lock, stock and barrel to Pando for use of government employes at the new ski troop training camp there. It was a deluxe camp of well constructed buildings, 30 of them.

Laborers from Fremont county are being used to raze the structures and it will take them 10 days to complete the job. At one time more than 200 CCC boys were housed there.

CCC Camp Located At Glenwood Will Be Used by Army

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, —The former CCC camp just south of Glenwood Springs will remain open this winter serving as a recreation camp to provide quarters to Camp Hale soldiers who are on week end passes into Glenwood Springs. *11/30/42*

Sgt. Edward Sobania is in charge of the camp and helping him are Pvt. Walter Snyder, in charge of the infirmary, and Pvt. Edmund Pfeifle. The camp formerly served the headquarters unit for Camp Hale during September and October.

This recreation camp is one of the few such camps where soldiers can stay while on passes, paying only a small charge for linen, in the Seventh Service Command.
