HS-On skin-Remove clothing, blot off vesicant - apply M4 ointment. Wash thoroughly.

In eyes-irrigate-boric acid and water.

M-1 On skin-Same as for HS. If hydrogen peroxide is available use for M4.

In eyes-irrigate or use Eye Solution M1.

PHOSGENE
OR OTHER
LUNG
IRRITANTS



Keep on mask as long as it is needed.

Treat as shock-Rest-Keep warm-give hot drink-Evacuate as litter cases.

IRRITANT SMOKES
CAUSING
SNEEZING, VOMITING
HEADACHE



Inhale chloride of lime. Rest and keep quiet. Take aspirin to relieve headache and bicarbonate of soda for stomach. Stay with your outfit.

TEAR
GAS



Face into the wind. Don't rub the eyes. Irrigate the eyes with water. Stay with your outfit.

WHITE
PHOSPHORUS
BURNS



Keep the burned part wet.

Use a wet cloth or mud.

Get to a medical officer.

REMEMBER-STOP BREATHING-PUT ON YOUR MASK-PROTECT YOUR BODY-KEEP YOUR HEAD AND USE IT!
