Dear Miss Mahlum:


The War Department recently announced that women who have been honorably discharged from enlisted status in the Women's Army Corps may volunteer for reentry into the service for the duration plus six months or until 30 September 1946, and will be reenlisted in the grade held at time of discharge.

Volunteers who possess skills the War Department can utilize are urgently needed to relieve the critical shortage of personnel at separation centers, hospitals, and other similar installations.

This Service Command is very proud of the women in this area who volunteered their services in order to help our nation reach a victory in the recent conflict.
