Students may present either a research project from work in Research Methods II, or a theoretical presentation based on a topic paper written in one of their courses. These can be papers from any course – Theories of Personality, Behavioral Neuroscience, History & Systems of Psychology, etc. Additionally, students may choose to present in a poster format, or a Power Point presentation.
